

§179D Commercial Building Tax Deductions

Commercial and large residential building owners can deduct up to \$1.80 per square foot of qualifying buildings through §179D

Under IRS §179D, real estate owners (and in some cases, architects and designers) can earn deductions as high as \$1.80 per square foot of the specific building or improvement. The deduction is in the amount of \$0.60 per SF for each of the building systems.

Eligible projects must reduce energy consumption in any of the following areas:

- Interior Lighting System
- HVAC and SHW System
- Envelope (building shell)

Reduction in energy consumption is calculated by comparing to ASHRAE Standard 90.1-2001, and must be certified by an independent qualified individual.

Energy improvements completed and placed in service between January 1, 2006 and December 31, 2013 are eligible for the deduction. (Note: Extended through 2013 as part of the Emergency Economic Stabilization Act of 2008.)

Architects and building designers may be eligible for a tax deduction by designing energy efficient buildings for federal, state, and local governments, including as public schools, state university buildings, public libraries, courthouses, student housing, & more.
